**Day 1: Discover Vienna**

In the afternoon sightseeing tour by bus showing all the highlights of the City like Opera House, Ringstraße, Hofburg Palace, the winter residence of the Habsburg Family, and Schoenbrunn, the Summer Palace. In this private tour your guests discover the tradition and history of Vienna.

**Day 2: Wine tasting**



After breakfast your guests visit two of the most excellent wine estates in Vienna, we choose from Edlmoser, Wieninger, Christ, Cobenzl and more. ### **Day 3: Gustav Klimt and the Modernism**
